

History OF SCCC

St. Clair Country Club a traditional, private, full service, family-oriented, social club located in the West End of Belleville, Illinois. St. Clair CC is one of the finest golf facilities in the St. Louis Metropolitan area and has been known for many years for its challenging, beautifully maintained golf course. St. Clair CC offers a full range of recreational and social amenities and contributes to the Belleville economic progress.

Founded in 1909, St. Clair has a distinctive character which combines facilities and service with a friendly atmosphere. The fundamental policy at St. Clair has always been that the Club exists for the use and enjoyment of its members. St. Clair's facilities and recreational programs are relatively uncrowded and easily accessible to the members.

Through the years, St. Clair has produced many quality golfers. Bill and Harvey Mertz brought honor early in the Club's association within the St. Louis District. The 1968 Masters Champion, Bob Goalby, was introduced to golf here at St. Clair Country Club in 1938 as a caddy. Jay & Jerry Haas, Bob Goalby's nephews, also got their start at the Club before becoming major contenders in the game.

Not many golf clubs hold the distinction of having three golf professionals, (Bob Goalby, Jay Haas, and Frank Conner), play in the same Masters Tournament as St. Clair CC did in 1985. Also, we would like to mention Frank Conner, who holds the distinct accomplishment of playing in the U.S. Open in both golf and tennis. Lastly, talented tennis star, Jimmy Connors, grew up in the St. Clair Country Club atmosphere and visits when not busy with the Senior Tennis Tour.




Registering Your SCCC ACCOUNT

Once your account has been registered on the website you can now download the mobile app.



All guests will be charged a guest fee and may not exceed 6 visits per year no matter how many different members he or she plays with. You may have up to 3 guests at any time, Monday through Friday. On weekends and holidays, prior to 10:00 a.m., the policy is "One Member - One Guest". After 10:00 a.m. you may have up to three (3) guests. Guests may play non-accompanied Monday through Thursday if sponsored by a member and with approval from the Director of Golf or Head Golf Professional.

Five-Somes

From April 9th through October 12th:

- Monday through Friday: Five-Somes will be permitted.
- Weekends and Holidays: Five-Somes will be permitted at the discretion of the Director of Golf or Head Golf Professional.

From October 16th through April 8th:

Five-Somes are permitted at any time.


Club Social Event INFORMATION

Billing & Payment INFORMATION

Monthly Statements

- A detailed statement is emailed to the Member of Record, a few days after the end of the month.
- · Member Statements reflect:
 - Charges made to the account and House Charge for the <u>current</u> month
 - The Monthly Dues and Capital Improvement for the <u>following</u> month
- Payments can be submitted in the following ways:
 - Automatic withdraw from a checking account on approximately the 15th of the month
 - Submitted in person in the Clubhouse during regular business hours
 - Sent to the Business Office via US Mail
- All payments must be received by the 20th of the month to avoid late fees.
- For your convenience, you can view your charges as they are posted to your account, throughout the month, online at www.stclaircc.com or on the SCCC Mobile App.
- Please contact the Accounts Receivable Clerk to set up automatic withdrawal or with any questions regarding your bill.

House Charge

To ensure we have quality staff to provide you with the utmost of service excellence, we charge our members a monthly House Service charge. This monthly service charge allows us to offer higher wages to our employees.

Food & Beverage Minimum

- Each member is charged a quarterly food and beverage minimum based on their membership category.
 - Active, Social, House, Senior = \$150 per quarter
 - Junior & Widow = \$75 per quarter
- If minimum is not met, the remaining balance will be charged to your statement each quarter.

Dining Reservations:

Members are asked to make reservations whenever they dine at the Club. Reservations are accepted in the Bar's Upper Level (Riser), Family Dining Room, Men's Grill and the Patio for lunch and dinner.

Reservations can be made one of three ways;

- Calling the Club Dining reservations can be made up to 2 weeks in advance by calling
 (618) 398-3400. All reservations for same day dining must be made via phone reservations.
- 2. <u>Online Website</u> Log in to the SCCC website, under Member Central and Dining Reservations to book reservations up to two weeks in advance.
- 3. Mobile App Click on the "Dining" tile to make reservations up to two weeks in advance.

Orders To-Go:

There are three ways to place To-Go orders:

- 1. <u>Calling the Club</u> Dial (618) 398-3400 and ask for a Server. When completed, your order will be placed by the front desk for pick-up. Please remember to sign your receipt before leaving.
- 2. <u>Mobile App</u> Open "Online Ordering" and follow the prompts. Choose from the following:
 - Bar & Grill If you are coming to the Club to pick-up your order. It will be
 placed at the front desk when completed.
 - Course Carryout If you are on the course and want your food to go. When completed, your order will be at the bar.
- 3. <u>Website</u> Click "Online Ordering" and follow the same directions as the mobile app
